Playgroup information

Sessions times are Mondays to Fridays: Morning sessions from 9:00am-12:00pm Afternoon sessions from 12:30-3:00pm All day sessions from 9:00am-3:00pm

Free places

All three and four year olds (and some two year olds) are entitled to up to 15 hours of pre-school education per week funded by the Government.

Some three and four olds are entitled to an additional 15 hours of childcare funded by the Government. Please ask us for details.

Additional sessions

We can sometimes offer additional sessions, over and above the 15 or 30 Government-funded hours. These are chargeable at £8 per session.

Key worker

For familiarity your child will be assigned a member of staff whose role is to establish a relationship with your child, to help settle them in and to address any questions or concerns you may have.

Working with parents

Ongoing communication between staff and parents is very important, and feedback in both directions is actively encouraged.

From time-to-time we invite parents to special events, including reviews of your child's learning log, to discuss how your child is progressing within the Early Years Foundation Stage framework. This includes:

- Communication and language
- Physical development
- · Personal, social and emotional development
- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the world
- · Expressive arts and design

Initial visits

We believe it is important for you as a parent to be comfortable that New Ark is the right place for your child, and that your child gets a gradual introduction to the pre-school environment. So, before children start at New Ark, we offer up to three visits where your child participates in a playgroup session with you observing.

These visits are charged at £1.50 each and are an opportunity for our staff to learn more about your child through discussion with you. Our staff are highly experienced in identifying and catering for a child's individual needs, a strength recognised by many who refer families to us.

Waiting list

We keep a list of parents interested in bringing their children to New Ark playgroup during our weekly Parent & Toddler Group. This is open to any child from 0 to 3 years who is accompanied by a parent or carer. See back page for details.

Staff – our Playgroup Leaders believe in providing a caring environment that nurtures the individual needs of young children. They have over 70 years of experience with pre-schoolers.
